MUSICAL COMEDY ARTIST

Trained as a lawyer, Henri Pauliat also took singing lessons at the Limoges conservatory where he unanimously obtained his prize in lyrical art in 2013.

Since 2011, he has been part of the Limoges Opera company on whose stage he has performed several roles in Fra Diavolo (Milord) in 2013, L'Affaire Tailleferre (the Shoemaker and the Notary) in 2014, "Un de la Canebière" (Toinet) in 2015 or in Quatre jours à Paris (Ferdinand) in 2016. He is also Borsa in the production of Rigoletto with the Figaro Si, Figaro Là company in 2013.

In addition to the classical repertoire, he is passionate about musical comedy and in 2014 co-founded the "Quartet", a vocal group with jazz, gospel and barber shop sounds.
